

In this video we will be going over the practice tests. When you see the homepage, you will be given options on that bottom banner, Select Practice Tests. And then the next screen will allow you to select the actual practice test website. Put in your email here, your password, and sign in. This is the next screen that allows you to see the practice tests. You will pick a student, in this case grade 5, a student with an intellectual disability and orthopedic impairment. I could pick one of the tests that I want to give so I will select ELA. As soon as I click on Ready, a speaker will orient you and the student to the practice test with a read aloud and then automatically move to the first item at which time I will stop the recording and explain the screen real estate. Please listen to all information and then touch the choice you think is correct. For a few writing items, you can trace on the screen, type in the text box, or write on a piece of paper. If you have questions, ask your teacher.

Here are three pictures with words. The dog is on the couch. Which word is couch? All right, so basically the practice test includes a number of options. I could replay that item, I could provide no answer, or I could answer it and move on, in which case I would click on the option, and then I would press next, and it would automatically go to the next item.

But before we do that, we can easily increase the speed of the speaker. Here are three pictures. The dog is on the couch. Which word is couch? So, that basically slows down or speeds up the speed of the speaker. We could also increase the size of the screen or decrease it. And then finally, we can go through each of these 12 practice test items in any order that we want. So, in this case, I will go on and then put next here are three pictures with words at a beach you can play, walk, and relax. What is the sentence about cow, farm, or beach? I'll pick beach, but then I'm going to exit the test and which case it's 2020, and I can exit. That would save the responses and I could then continue the test later. Once you are done with the student and all the items, you'll get a code that will be on that left side and that will be filled in for each of these areas in which case you would have submitted incomplete, not started, discontinued, or not applicable. And those are the letters of the codes that will appear there.
